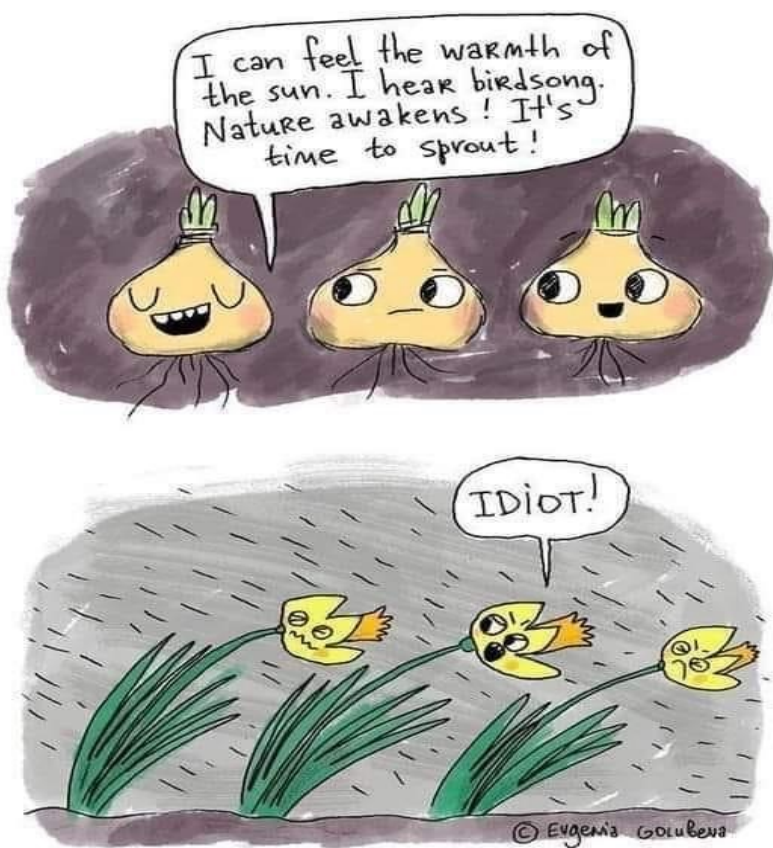

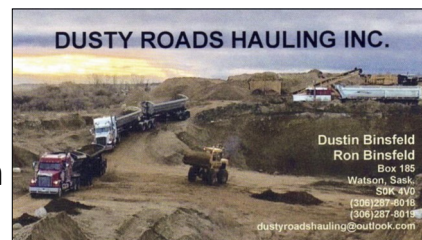

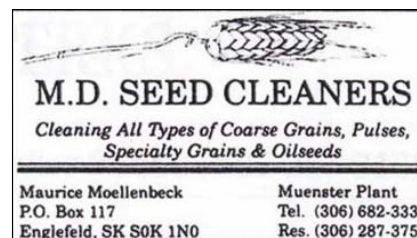

Pig House News

The little pig house by the highway has had a lot of visitors since it went up in 2015. A wooden pig mailbox was added in 2016. It received a lot of "mail" but it didn't weather well so



in 2020 it was replaced with a plastic 3d printed version. It has been interesting to read the notes left by the visitors. A total of 686 have been left from people far and wide. Many indicated where they were from, including these Canadian provinces:

- 119 Saskatchewan
- 59 Alberta
- 36 Manitoba
- 19 B.C.
- 12 Ontario
- 2 New Brunswick
- 2 Newfoundland
- 3 Northwest Territories

Also from other countries:

9 from United States (2 New Jersey, 3 Texas, 2 Arizona, 2 Wisconsin)
3 England, 1 Mexico, 1 Australia, 1 South Africa, 1 Germany, 1 Ukraine
417 did not indicate where they were from.

Of course many people who stop don't take the time to leave a note. We even had a horticulture tour bus stop in 2019.
