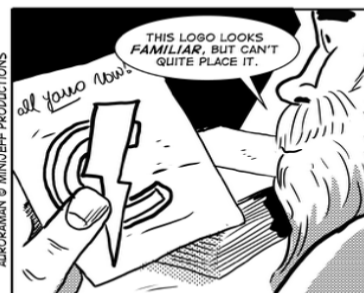
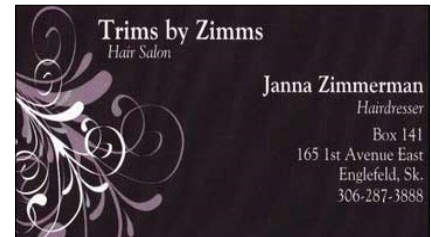
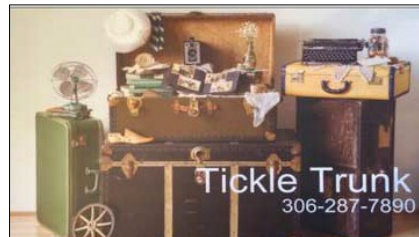


## SCC NEWS...

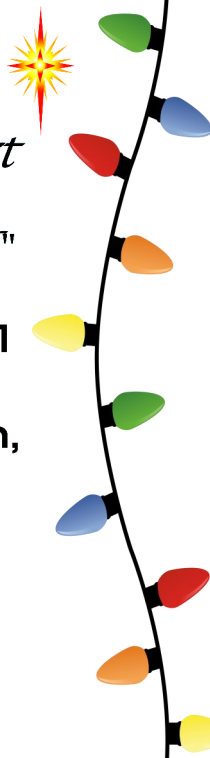
