**Catholic Women's League...** Our dues have been raised due to the rise in cost of so much. It is so important that we keep our status as a National League. The fees we send to National are used for the following: Expenses for our national executive to attend world women's conferences; travel to meet with our Prime Minister and other elected officials in Ottawa to give input on our issues of the day; Sponsoring league members to attend and upgrade conventions; monies to COADY worldwide (educates women in poor countries); to help pay expenses for our National meeting that members of our local councils and diocese try to attend; to help publish our league magazine office and small staff expenses.

Locally we are still one of the biggest councils with 33 members paid up, and three members we pay for that are in care homes. Here is some of what we do locally: have a mass read for all members living and deceased every month, our large number of members gains us access to our elected officials so we can bring to their attention issues of concern to us. We give hundreds of monies to charitable groups, including: Father Francis for help in his home in Ghana, Ronald McDonald House in Saskatoon, Soup Kitchen & Food Bank in Humboldt, fireworks for Hogfest, local grad awards and gifts, keepsake baptismal gowns and candles, local music festivals, the BAA, and Cancer & Mental Health Research. We are also now in charge of funeral lunches as well.

This gives you an idea of how much your membership matters. Thank-you to each of you.
