Ingredients:

- 35 soup crackers
- 2 sticks (1 cup) butter
- 1 C packed brown sugar
- 1 3/4 C semi-sweet choc chips
- Holiday M&M's
- Holiday sprinkles
- Mini marshmallows

Preheat oven to 350°. Line a sheet pan, and lightly spray it. Line with crackers in a single layer. In medium saucepan, melt butter & brown sugar. Bring to a boil, stir continuously, about 2 mins. Pour over crackers in even layer. Bake 5-6 mins. Top with chocolate chips, bake for another 3 mins or til melted. Spread slightly, then top with as much of your M&M's, sprinkles & mini marshmallows as you want. Once cooled or when chocolate is set, cut into squares or break into pieces.
