

Recipe: Brown Butter Oatmeal Chocolate Chip Squares

Ingredients:

2C flour
1tsp baking soda
1tsp baking powder
Pinch of salt
2.5C old fashioned oats
1/2tsp cinnamon
1.5C brown sugar
1 1/4C brown butter (or just melted butter)
2 eggs
1tbsp vanilla
2—2.5C choc chips of your choice

Directions:

Combine all ingredients in one bowl! (If you are using browned butter, allow to cool for 15 mins before mixing up your ingredients!) Dump in a 9x13" greased pan, push down into an even layer. Bake in a 350° preheated oven for 20-22 minutes. Allow to cool completely before slicing.




A blonde and her boyfriend went to a football game. They had great seats—right behind their team's bench. After the game, the boyfriend asked the blonde what she thought of the game.
