



Blueberry Banana Oatmeal Muffins

Ingredients:

- 4 large bananas
- 4 eggs
- 4tbsp coconut or olive oil
- 1/2 C honey
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 C AP flour
- 1 C whole wheat flour
- 1 C rolled oats
- 4 tsp baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- 1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries (or sub choc. Chips)

Directions:

Preheat your oven to 350 degrees F. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the mashed bananas, eggs, oil, honey & vanilla extract. Next add in the flour, oats, salt and baking powder. Don't overmix but make sure it is well combined. Then fold in your blueberries with a spatula. This recipe makes roughly 20 standard sized muffins or 9-10 large muffins. Bake regular sized muffins for 20-25 mins, and large muffins for 30-35 mins, or until a toothpick comes out clean.

- ◆ Plastic overwrap from paper towels, toilet paper, mattresses, electronics, flats of canned beverages
- ◆ Plastic food storage bags: sandwich, freezer and vacuum seal bags
- ◆ Shrink wrap
- ◆ Bubble wrap
- ◆ Potato chip bags, crinkly plastic bags from candy, cereal, granola bar wrappers, cheese slice plastic
- ◆ Plastic net bags from fruit and veggies

... and so much more!!

NOT ACCEPTED: garbage bags, rigid plastic containers, plastic squeeze tubes, clam shells, and more.

FOAM PACKAGING

What is accepted:

- ◆ Plastic foam containers and trays used for meat and produce
- ◆ Foam egg cartons
- ◆ Foam clamshells, cups and bowls from take-out food
- ◆ Firm foam cushion packaging to protect electronics, small appliances, etc

NOT ACCEPTED: labels/tape/ paper and cardboard on foam packaging, foam peanuts & packing chips, foam insulation, foam pool noodles, foam furniture cushions, and more.

NON-DEPOSIT GLASS

What is accepted:

- ◆ clear and coloured non-deposit glass bottles/jars
- ◆ Food jars (pickles, condiments, jams/jellies, salsa, etc)
- ◆ Food bottles (Vinegars, syrups, extracts & oils)
- ◆ Baby food & home canning jars

NOT ACCEPTED: drinking glasses/ dishes, cookware, whole or broken glass, light bulbs & fixtures and more.


